# Region 13 Picnic

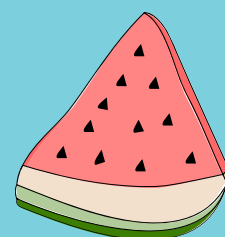

This service project is a great way to spend free summer days! You do not need to be Christian to attend this event; you will be making props for the theme!

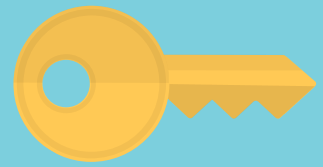
